A lovely picnic and wonderful time was had by all on a beautiful day.

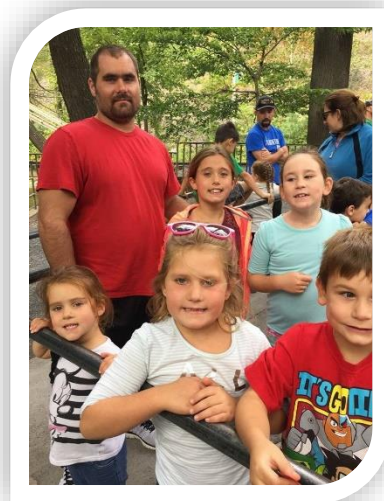
